



Welcome to Central Florida Pediatrics! This packet contains all the information you will need to get your child established with our practice.

Please complete the following items and bring them with you to your first visit:

- 1) The “Patient Information” sheet. You may list 2 children per sheet. This will be updated each calendar year.
- 2) The “Financial Statement and Authorizations” form. You may list all children on one form. This will be updated each calendar year.
- 3) The “Consent For Care” should be completed and notarized if you intend for anyone other than a parent or legal guardian to have authority to bring your child and give consent for treatment at our office. *NOTE: only a parent or legal guardian can bring a child for their initial visit.* This will be updated each calendar year.
- 4) The “Patient Health History” form, front side only.

You will also need to bring:

- 1) A photo identification (i.e. driver’s license).
- 2) Your insurance card(s). Please remember if you have a newborn you must add the baby to your policy within 30 days.

Upon arrival, children under the age of 2 months may sign-in and go directly to our “newborn waiting” area. If you have not had a tour of our office, please ask the receptionist to direct you.

We request that patients do not wear heavy colognes/perfumes when visiting our office, as these may cause breathing complications for our asthmatic patients. We also request that patients do not use cellular phones while in the exam rooms.
